WEEK TWELVE

Art Theme - A Christmas project

Make some Christmas cards to send to friends and relatives. Cut out pictures from old cards and paste them on construction paper on which you write your own Christmas greeting.

Drawing - chalice and water pitcher

Art 2 for Young Catholics: Read the Scripture and color the picture on page 36. Draw the chalice as shown on page 37. Read the Bible story and color the picture on page 38. Draw the water pitcher as shown page 39.

WEEK THIRTEEN

Art Theme - Christmas cookies

Help Mom bake some cookies and make Christmas designs on them with frosting. Or decorate a birthday cake for Jesus.

Drawing - candlestick

Art 2 for Young Catholics: Read the story and color the picture on page 40. Draw the candlestick as shown on page 41.

WEEK FOURTEEN

Art Theme - decorations for the Christmas tree

Cut out designs (such as a Christmas bell) in felt, two at a time. Paste a piece of cardboard between them for stiffness. Decorate them using sequins and then hang them on the tree.

Drawing - chair and table

Art Theme - Snow

If you have snow, make a snowman. If not, draw a snowman. Look at pictures of snowmen in children's books to get ideas for how to decorate your snowman.

Art Theme - a family party
