



Day 3

Write the spelling words in alphabetical order on the left side of the page. Read and discuss the spelling tips, which are important concepts leading into further lessons. Complete the exercises using spelling words from the lesson. These exercises include writing list words that are homophones, rhyming words, and/or words having the indicated syllables. Check your spelling. Correct any misspelled words and rewrite them five times each. Some of these exercises have more than one possible answer. Only one answer is required. The answer key in the back of the book includes all possible answers. Remember that homophones are words that have the same pronunciation and different spelling and meaning. Memorizing the spelling of homophones will help you to remember the spelling patterns for other words.

Day 4

Spell aloud and trace the spelling words. Fold the paper in half, turning the words under so they cannot be seen. Listen to the words as they are dictated alone and within a sentence. Write each word carefully. Unfold the paper and check your spelling immediately after completing the test. Correct any misspelled words and rewrite them five times each.

Day 5

Listen to the words as they are dictated alone and within a sentence. Write each word carefully on a separate sheet of paper. Correct any misspelled words, and rewrite them five times each.

END OF QUARTER

The last week of each quarter is set aside to review the list words studied during the quarter or during the previous eight weeks. At the end of each quarter, please dictate the words specified in this Lesson Plan for the quarter test. Attach the test to the corresponding Quarter Report Form and send it Seton for grading.
