#### **WEEK THIRTY-SIX**

### Take the 4th Quarter Test.

We believe this is sufficient for third graders.

The authors believe that the average student can do one exercise a day. However, that will be up to you. You will notice that there are four or five exercises per chapter list.

Notice that the Answer Key follows this lesson plan.

Please give your child a quiz as each chapter is completed. This may be oral or written. **Ask your child** to provide at least one definition for each word in the chapter.

Please grade the chapter quizzes and put the grades on the Quarter Report Form. At the end of each quarter, average the quizzes and fill in the quiz average.

When your child has finished the five lessons for the quarter, please assign the Seton Quarter Test. Please send the test to Seton for grading along with the appropriate Quarter Report Form.

If you wish to send the home grade average over the Internet, you may do so by going to our Seton web site at www.setonhome.org. Click on My Seton, then Log On. In the upper right hand corner, be sure you click on the name of the student. You will immediately see the box for the home grade, but you need to enter the Item ID number, which is on your paper quarter report form. If you are not sure how to proceed, click on "What's This?" and follow the directions. The computer will automatically average your home grades with the test grades, once all the grades are entered.

Scroll down to the chart and notice each course listed for each quarter. You can "view" or write in the home grade, or click on an icon.

You will see on the chart that you can upload, or send an assignment to Seton to be graded.

Each assignment in every course can be sent to Seton over the Internet, though you may need to scan the work into the computer. They can be sent as the student does the tests; you don't need to wait until the end of the quarter to send them. These tests or assignments are graded by a teacher on the computer. The grades will go into the report card database, and the graded test will be sent back to you over the Internet.

Developing vocabulary is important. These words and definitions will stretch the mind of your child. However, the proper use of these vocabulary words can best be maintained through the daily reading of good books.
