#### **INTRODUCTION**

We encourage you to purchase a thesaurus for this grade level. Seton sells an Intermediate Thesaurus for grades 5 and 6. You may find one at your local bookstore. If your student uses a thesaurus, vocabulary assignments and writing assignments will improve.
