## **WEEK SEVEN**

### **Day 1**

#### **Lesson 25: Direct Questions**

**OPTIONAL VIDEO:** Watch the first of two Lesson 25 video lectures. Log on to your MySeton page, click on Video Tutorials, scroll down to Latin, and click on the video called Latin II, Lesson 25: Direct Questions.

Read p. 267. Memorize the vocabulary on the same page. Read **Note** on p. 268. Do Exercises 279 and 280.

**OPTIONAL AUDIO:** Go to the Weekly Audio page, scroll down to Week 7, and click on Vocabulary, p. 267.

### **Day 2**

Do Exercises 281 and 282. Be sure you know how to use *nonne* and *num* in *Latin Grammar* no. 503. Memorize the vocabulary on p. 269. Do Exercise 283.

**OPTIONAL AUDIO:** Go to the Weekly Audio page, scroll down to Week 7, and click on Vocabulary, p. 269.

Memorize nos. 502 and 503 in *Latin Grammar*.

### **Day 3**

**OPTIONAL VIDEO:** Watch the second of two Lesson 25 video lectures. Log on to your MySeton page, click on Video Tutorials, scroll down to Latin and click on Latin II, Lesson 25 Pt 2.

Omit Exercise 284 on p. 270-271. Do Exercise 285 orally. Read and study pp. 271-272. Memorize the vocabulary on p. 272. Do Exercise 286.

**OPTIONAL AUDIO:** Go to the Weekly Audio page, scroll down to Week 7, and click on Vocabulary, p. 272.

Memorize no. 140 in *Latin Grammar*.

### **Day 4**

Find Exercise 287 in the answer key of your Course Manual. Translate that exercise from the Latin and then compare your translation to Exercise 287 on p. 273 of *First Year Latin*. Omit Exercise 288. Do Exercise 289 on p. 274 orally.

Read and study pp. 274-275. Memorize the vocabulary on p. 275.



Now go to the answer key of your Course Manual, find Exercise 290, and translate the Latin into English. Compare your translation to the English in Exercise 290 on p. 275-276 in the text.

**OPTIONAL AUDIO:** Go to the Weekly Audio page, scroll down to Week 7, and click on Vocabulary, p. 275.

### **Day 5**

Do Exercises 291 and 292 on pp. 276-277.

## **WEEK EIGHT**

### **Day 1**

Omit Reading No. 18. Do Exercise 293 on p. 279. Review Lesson 25 for Test 5. If written work helps prepare you for the test, translate Reading No. 18 on pp. 277-279. Ask St. Cecilia for help in your review and on the test.

### **Day 2**

**Take Test 5 on Lesson 25. This is a parent-graded test.**

If you are dissatisfied with your score, review and study the material. In your review look for the types of questions you got wrong on the test. Then take the test again.

### **Day 3**

**Lesson 26: The Perfect System Active of the Subjunctive**

**OPTIONAL VIDEO: Watch the video lecture on Lesson 26. Log on to your MySeton page, click on Video Tutorials, scroll down to Latin, and click on Latin II, Lesson 26.**

Read and study p. 280 in *First Year Latin*. Memorize the vocabulary on p. 280. Do the even numbered words in Exercise 294. Example: *perven-, pervenerit, pervenerint, pervenisset, pervenissent*. Do Exercise 295 orally. Have a friend or family member check you on your answers as you go. Use the *Latin Grammar* if necessary.

Memorize nos. 200-207 in *Latin Grammar*.

**Optional Audio:** For a presentation on Lesson 26, go to the Weekly Audio page, scroll down to Week 8, and click on Lesson 26, p. 280. Then click on GR 200, 202-204. For the vocabulary, click on Vocabulary, p. 280.



### **Day 4**

Read and study pp. 281-282. Memorize the vocabulary on p. 283. Be sure to read **Related English Words**. Do Exercise 296. Do the first three parts orally. Omit part 4. Write out your translations for part 5.

Memorize nos. 524-526 in *Latin Grammar*.

**OPTIONAL AUDIO:** Go to the Weekly Audio page, scroll down to Week 8, and click on Indirect Questions, p. 281 and Sequence of Tenses (p. 282) & GR 524-526. Click on Vocabulary, p. 283.

### **Day 5**

Do Exercise 297 and Reading No. 19 on pp. 284-286. Write out the translations. Do Exercise 298 on p. 284 orally.

## **WEEK NINE**

### **Day 1**

Read and study pp. 286-287 in *First Year Latin*. Be sure to revisit *Latin Grammar* nos. 524-526. Memorize the vocabulary on p. 287. Read **Note** on the same page. Do Exercise 299. Do the odd numbered sentences in Exercise 300.

**OPTIONAL AUDIO:** Go to the Weekly Audio page, scroll down to Week 9, and click on Vocabulary, p. 287.

### **Day 2**

Do Exercise 301 on pp. 288-289. Translate only. Do the first 5 sentences of Exercise 302.

### **Day 3**

Exercise 303 on p. 290 is an indispensable review for Unit Seven. Today you should go through each of these 17 sentences and make sure you understand the concepts presented. Review for Test 6.

### **Day 4**

Write out your translation for Reading No. 20 on pp. 290-292. (If you are unfamiliar with the Battle of Bataan, we suggest researching it online.)

Review for Test 6. Be sure you know the endings of the subjunctives covered in *First Year Latin* and *Latin Grammar*. Know how to use the subjunctives. Review their use in indirect questions. Study relative clauses and how they work. Review all vocabulary. Pray to St. Cecilia to help you with your studies and the test.
