Subject / Predicate Agreement: Special Subjects: These are tricky and students often forget these items. Do the exercise after you understand the lesson.

Inverted sentences are always tricky unless you follow the rule: look for the verb first, then look for the subject. Memorize this rule. Try to get in the habit of changing the sentence around to the usual order.

Active and Passive Voices: Read the explanation carefully. It is important to understand the passive voice because when you study a foreign language, you will need to use the correct ending of the verb.

Review past lessons. Read and study lesson 66. Be sure that you understand how to form the simple tenses and the perfect tenses. Complete exercises 66A-C.

This is a little tricky, but if you concentrate, you will understand it. Students commonly write the wrong tense for the second verb. It has become so common that most people do not even recognize it even after it is corrected.

**Day 1**

Review past lessons. Read and study lessons 69-71. Complete the exercises.

It is important to learn the subjunctive mood because in foreign languages, the endings change because of the subjunctive mood. Purdue University explains, "When verbs show something contrary to fact, the verb is in the subjunctive mood."



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**Day 2**
