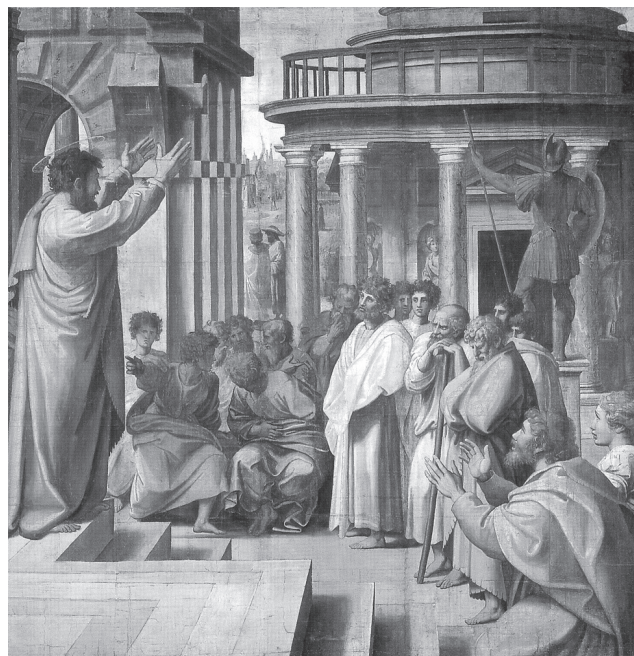
complacent: We Catholics must not become complacent about the social evils around us.

cherubic: There are over 50 references to the cherubims in the Bible. 3 Kings 6:27: And he set the cherubims in the midst of the inner temple; and the cherubims stretched forth their wings. And the wing of the one touches one wall, and the wing of the cherub touched the other wall; and the other wings in the midst of the temple touched one another.
