WEEK SIX

Day 1

Do Exercise 35. Read pp. 38-39 in your textbook. Memorize the vocabulary on p. 39.

OPTIONAL AUDIO: Go to the Weekly Audio page, scroll down to Week 6, and click on Vocabulary, page 39.

Day 2

Do Exercise 36 on p. 40. (Remember: you do not need to diagram Latin sentences.) Do Exercise 37 on p. 40.

Day 3

Do Exercises 38-40 on pp. 41-42. You may do part 1 of Exercise 40 orally.

Day 4

Read The Expletive *There* on p. 42 and Note on p. 43. Memorize the vocabulary on p. 42. Do Exercise 41 on p. 43.
