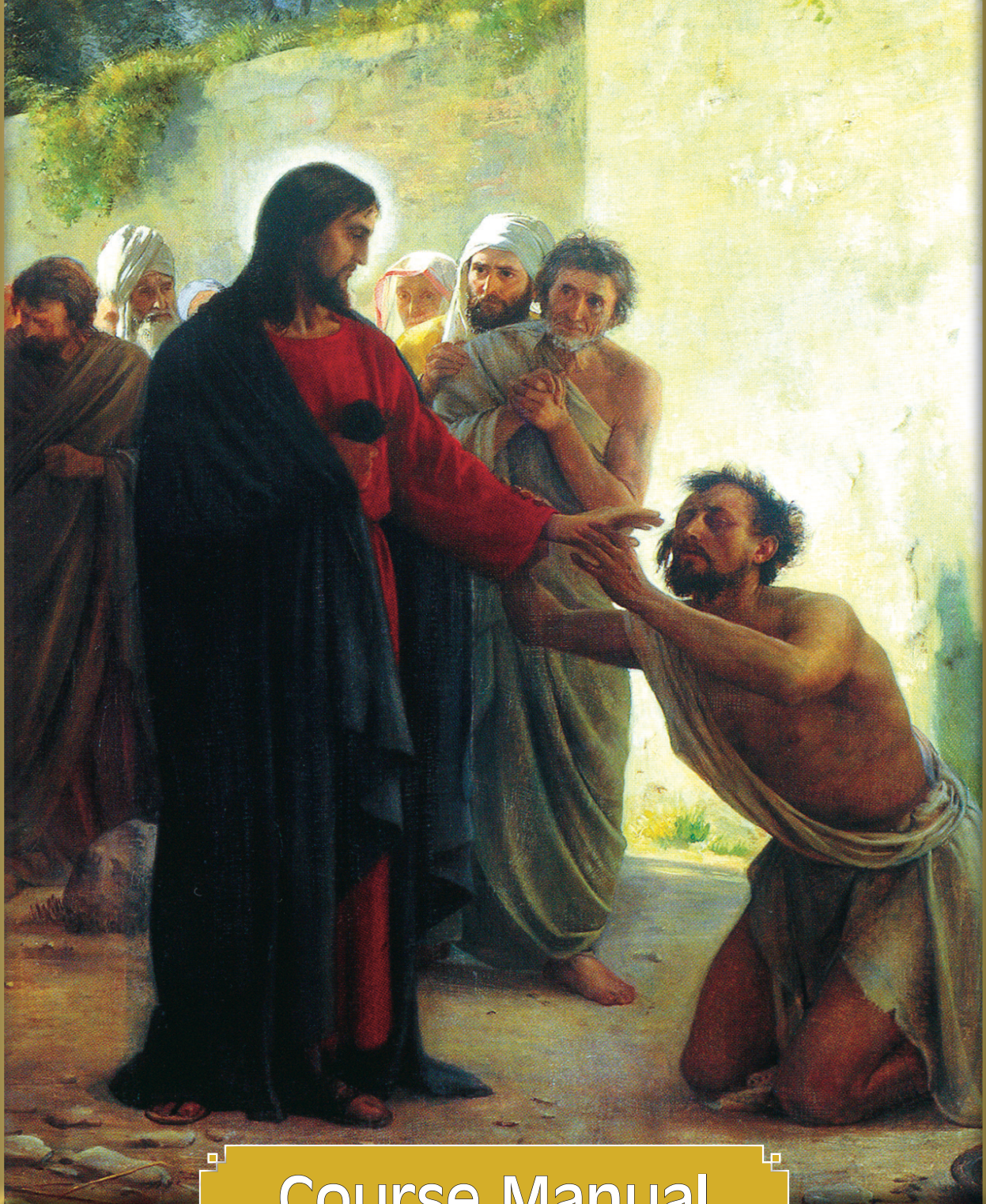

Read and study pp. 246-248 in *First Year Latin*. (As stated in the video, students often run into trouble with relative clauses, not because of the Latin so much as our own casual misuse of them in English. Be sure you understand the correct use of relative pronouns in English.) Memorize the vocabulary on p. 248.

Memorize *Latin Grammar* nos. 139 and 479.

OPTIONAL AUDIO: Go to the Weekly Audio page, scroll down to Week 4, and click on Lesson 24, p. 246. Click on GR 139. Click on Vocabulary, p. 248.

Day 5

Reread pp. 246-247 in *First Year Latin*. Do Exercises 263 and 264 on pp. 248-250. You may do part 2 of Exercise 264 orally. Omit part 3.

WEEK FIVE

Day 1

Do the even numbered sentences in Exercise 265 through sentence 20. Orally translate Exercise 266 on p. 251 and Reading No. 15 on p. 252.

Day 2

OPTIONAL VIDEO: Watch the second of three Lesson 24 video lectures. Log on to MySeton page, click on Video Tutorials, scroll down to Latin, and click on Latin II, Lesson 24 Pt 2.

Read pp. 253-255 in *First Year Latin*. Memorize the vocabulary on p. 254. Do the first 10 sentences in Exercise 267.

Day 3
