Chapter IV DISCUSSION

- 1. Why is it reasonable to conclude that God would give a revelation to man?
- 2. Show how Hinduism, Buddhism, Confucianism, and Paganism could not be the true religion.
- 3. What special revelation did the Jews have?

COMMENTARY on Chapter IV: The treatment given to non-Christian religions is relatively brief because the purpose is to give one or two conclusive reasons why each could not be the true religion. It is important to avoid the trap of "comparative religions," which implies that all are equal.
