



202	Counting with Numbers: Page 2. Read the instructions on the page before teaching your child. The instructions on this page also apply to nine other pages, as noted on page 2. Stress the rhyming aspect found on these pages. Repeating the rhyming words in a fun-song way will help your child more effectively learn the numbers.
	Teach your child the Number One. Show him one finger, one nose, one mouth, one sun, one moon, one M&M, one pretzel, one flower, and so on.
	Tell your child there is One God.
