## Week One

Read the title page, "About the Back Cover" and information on the back of the title page, the dedication, and the table of contents. Skim over the index and list of maps in the back of the book. Skim through the book to see how each chapter is set up, with two pages of end-of chapter review questions.

Look over Chapter One: The Dawn of History. Read the sub-headings in the chapter, look over the pictures. Read the review questions at the end of the chapter.

Read, study pp. 1 to 3, about the Asians who crossed into the American continent. Look on a map for Alaska, the Bering Strait, and the Aleutian Islands.

## Day 4

Read, study p. 3 to top of p. 6, about the decrease of nomadic life and the various groups of Indians on the American continent. Read about these groups of Indians in books in the library. What kind of Indians once lived in your state or province?

Read, study pp. 42 to 44, about the Aztecs, Cortez, and Montezuma. This book is focusing on some of the Catholics who helped shape the new nation. Read about Hernan Cortez, a hero who saved hundreds of thousands of people from being killed, and brought the Catholic Faith to the new world.
