	Religion 5 for Young Catholics: Introductory Matter	
	In Religion 5 for Young Catholics, read the Preface and the Introduction . Notice the details in the painting of St. Anne teaching Mary the Scriptures when she was young. How do we know the scroll is of the Scriptures? Look at little Mary's hands folded in prayer. The other painting shows how guardian angels are always with us, even when we are sleeping.	;
	Religion 5: Read Chapter One, The Apostles' Creed, pp. 2-3. Fill in the blanks on p. 3. Read the prayer.	
	Study the details of the illustration: The Blessed Mother is holding Baby Jesus. There are two men in the painting. How can we identify St. Joseph? What is he holding? In the lower right corner, we see His cousin, the child St. John the Baptist with his mother, St. Elizabeth. The man in the back is St. Zacharias (Zachary) the father of St. John. Note the angels over the Christ Child and the roses.

the Rosary, the Stations of the Cross, and the Mass.

Look over the Bible History 5 for Young Catholics: The Acts of the Apostles and the Early Church, the covers, and the inside covers. Look over the title page and the back of the title page for the Nihil Obstat and Imprimatur. Who gave them? Read the Table of Contents and the illustrations.

The two angels in the forefront incense the Christ Child in adoration. Page 9, though a simple painting of God the Father, the details of His face and hands are emphasized by the simplicity around Him. Page 10, God the Father. The globe represents the fact that He is the Creator of the Earth, and of all things on Earth. His hand upon the globe shows that He keeps all things in existence. Notice the baby faces of the angels in the background; the three musical angels singing from a scroll.
