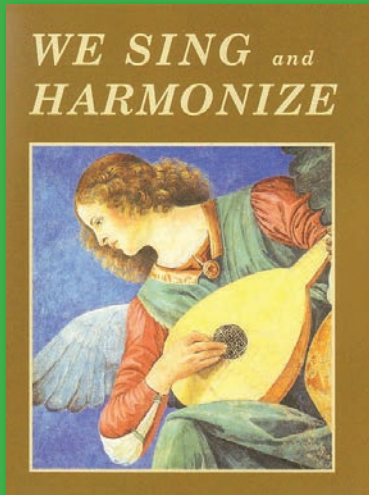

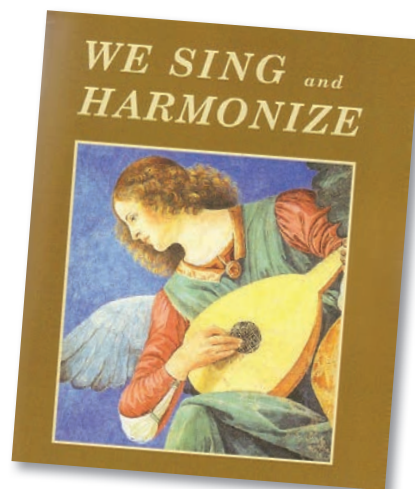

# FIRST QUARTER

## Weeks One to Nine

You can check off work as you complete it!



Skim over the *We Sing and Harmonize* songbook. Notice the dedication to St. Joseph the Workman, Foster Father of the Son of God, and Patron of the Universal Church. Read the Table of Contents, which is arranged according to the Liturgical Year. Skim over the illustrations. Notice the religious songs and Mass hymns, the Gregorian chant, and songs to the Blessed Mother and to St. Joseph.



If you know how to play the piano or some other musical instrument, play this instrument while singing to keep your child on key.



During the First Quarter, your child should sing all the After Pentecost songs and about half of the Advent songs in *We Sing and Harmonize*.
