

SPELLING 6 LESSON PLAN

INTRODUCTION

Important course information is located in the front of the workbook. Please review these pages very carefully.

We recommend that students have a dictionary. The biggest secret of excellent spellers is that they have a dictionary close by. Good students know the importance of using a dictionary to help them with both spelling and the meaning of words. *Merriam-Webster's Intermediate Dictionary* (Grades 5-6) is available for purchase from Seton Educational Media (SEM) at www.setonbooks.com; phone: (866) 241-8819.

Please be aware that the First Quarter includes Lessons 1-8; the Second Quarter includes Lessons 10-17; the Third Quarter includes Lessons 19-26; and the Fourth Quarter includes Lessons 28-35. Lessons 9, 18, 27, and 36 are not included in the workbook, because these are review and testing weeks.

At the end of each weekly lesson, we recommend that you give a weekly spelling test by dictating the words to your student. To send these grades to Seton, you may either record these grades in Section A of the appropriate Quarter Report Form and mail it to Seton at the end of the quarter or submit these grades to Seton online at any time.

To submit grades online, go to the Seton website (www.setonhome.org), log on to your MySeton page, click on Courses, and scroll down to Spelling 6. Then click on "view" under the correct quarter. You will see a yellow box for the home grade. To enter a grade, click on "Enter Parent Grades." This will open a new blank box in place of the yellow one under "Grade." Type the grade in this box, and click on "Submit Parent Grades."

QUARTER TESTS

At the end of each quarter, please dictate the words specified in the quarter test and send the test to Seton. You may either mail the test to Seton with the appropriate Quarter Report Form or scan the test and submit it to Seton online. To submit tests online, log on to your MySeton page, click on Courses, scroll down to Spelling 6, and then click on the icon for uploading work. Another option is to have your child take the tests directly online. Audios dictating the spelling words for the quarter tests are available from your MySeton page.

INTEGRATING SPELLING WITH OTHER SUBJECTS

After reviewing the basic spelling rules and word patterns taught in each lesson, you may want to apply these spelling lessons to words taken from other subjects. In this case, be sure to have your student identify the spelling rules or word

patterns in each word. Learning to spell difficult words can help a student to memorize the words as they apply to the subject matter.
