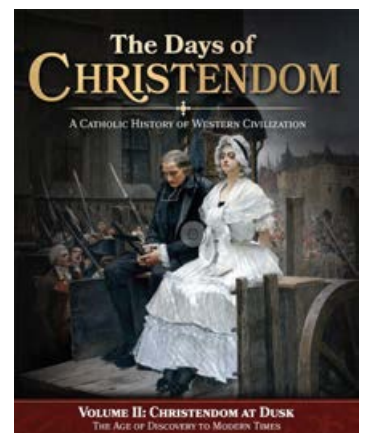
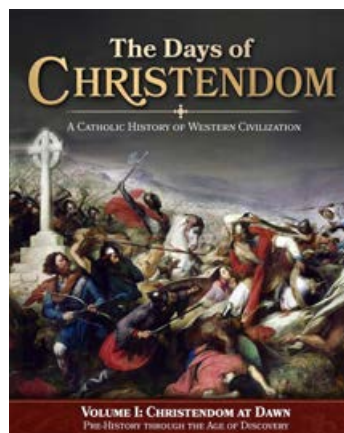

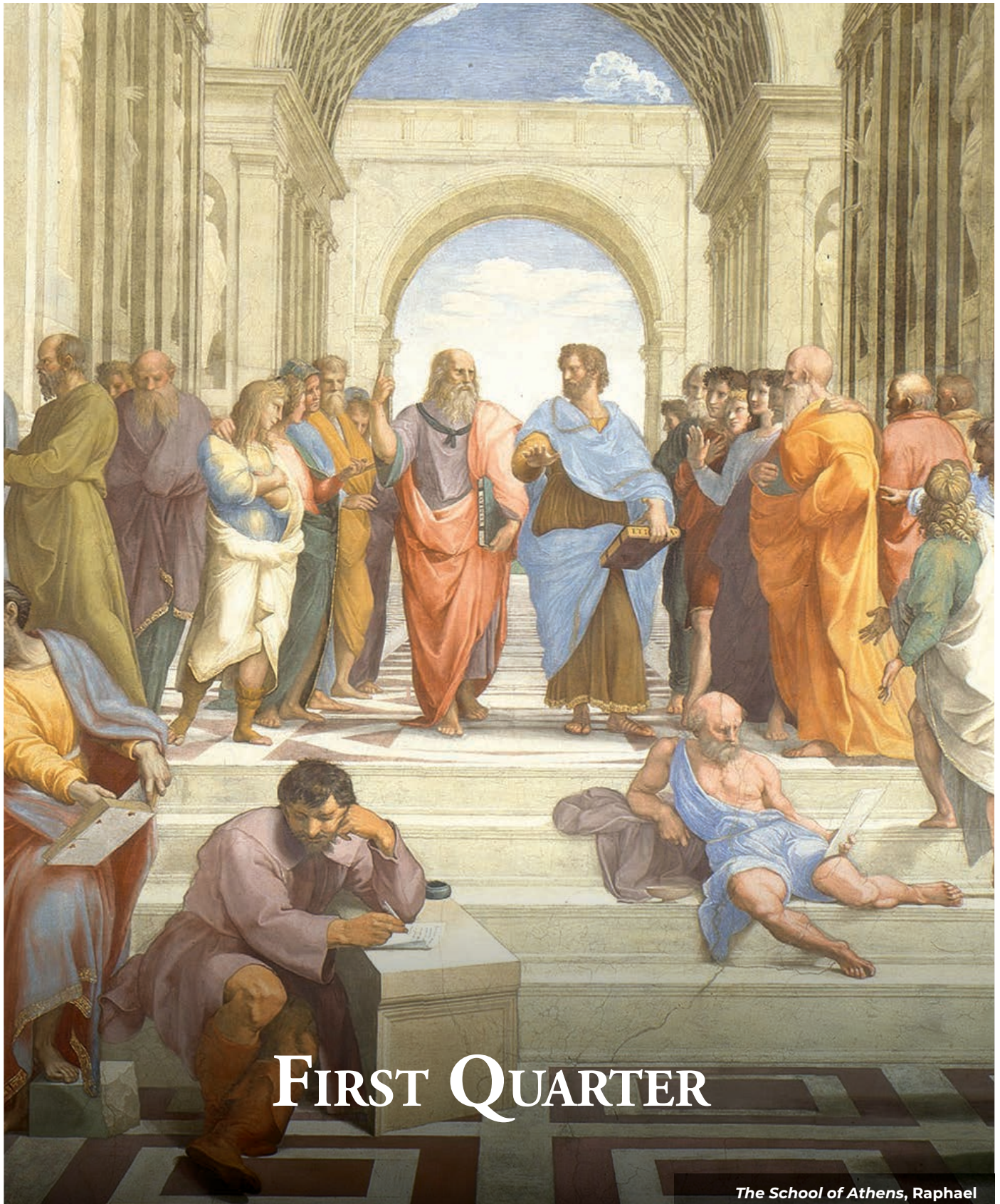

Part A multiple choice tests represent 60% of your total quarter grade. Part B short answer tests represent 40% of your total quarter grade.

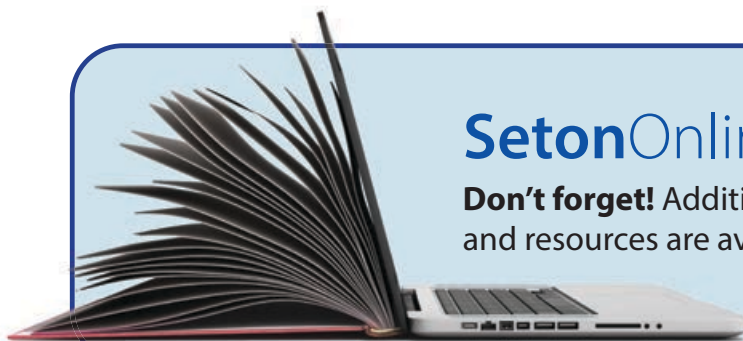
